KS1 Newsletter #5


Year 1

This week in Year 1, we have been looking at using our senses to describe a setting. We have looked in depth at the museum in our book 'Lost in the Toy Museum' and thought about what we could see, hear, feel, smell and taste. We have been busy finishing our maths unit on addition and subtraction this week and have moved onto place value within 20. The afternoons have been filled with learning about the first aeroplane flight by the Wright brothers, reading and Cosmic Yoga! We have been continuing to learn new phonemes and recap old ones in phonics and put these new sounds into practice by reading words and captions. A lot of children in Year 1 have loved having a story at the end of the day which has inspired them to create artwork based on the story. Year 2

In Year 2, we have been using the multiplication symbol in maths alongside pictures to solve calculations. We have also been recapping our 2 and 5 times tables and looking at doubling. In English, we have been completing work on our beautiful book, 'The Bear and the Piano'; making predictions, asking questions, thinking about the protagonist's (main character's) decision, creating noun phrases and looking at contracted words. We completed our unit on The Great Fire of London in history and in art, looked carefully at how to draw expressive faces. We created our own bar charts in ICT, after completing a tally chart and even had time for Cosmic Yoga and PE with Joe Wicks. What another busy week, Year 2!




